## First Nine Weeks Skills

Count to 25  
Count backwards from 10  
Count forward beginning with a given number (0-25)  
Name numerals 0 - 10 out of sequence  
Match quantities to numerals 0 - 10  
Write numerals 0 - 10  
Order numerals 0 - 10  
Decompose (separate) numbers 0-5 into two parts  
Sort a collection (of 10 or less) by color, size, shape, kind and compare groups  
Identify penny and its value  
Identify the position of objects  
Name & describe in the environment two-dimensional shapes:  
circle, oval, square, rectangle, triangle,  
diamond, hexagon, trapezoid  
Create and compose two-dimensional shapes  
Identify smaller shapes within a larger shape  
Identify book elements  
Follow words from left to right, top to bottom, and page by page  
Demonstrate one-to-one correspondence  
Name all 26 uppercase and lowercase letters in random order & in text  
Recognize rhyming words  
Understand syllables  
Read sight words  
Write first name correctly



## Second Nine Weeks Skills

Count to 50  
Count forward beginning with a given number (0-50)  
Name numerals 0 - 20 out of sequence  
Match quantities to numerals 0 - 20  
Write numerals 0 - 20  
Order numerals 0 - 20  
Compare numerals and sets 0-10 to determine greater than, less than or equal to  
Skip count by 10's to 100  
Decompose (separate) numbers 0-10 into two parts  
Identify nickel and its value  
Name and describe in the environment three-dimensional shapes:  
sphere, cube, cone, cylinder  
Create and compare three-dimensional shapes  
Retell familiar story  
Identify story elements: character  
Produce rhyming words  
Read sight words  
Identify beginning sound  
Identify letter sounds (uppercase and lowercase)  
Mm, Tt, Aa, Ss, Pp, Cc, Ii, Bb, Nn, Rr, Dd, Kk  
Write the letter for each sound (see above)  
Blend segment onsets and rimes  
Write first and last name correctly  
Print upper- and lowercase letters: Mm, Tt, Aa, Ss,  
Pp, Cc, Ii, Bb, Nn, Rr, Dd, Kk  
Produce a complete sentence (dictated)  
Draw/dictate/write to state an opinion  
Form plural nouns  
Identify opposites  
Recognize and use sentence structure: Capitalization



## Third Nine Weeks Skills

Count to 75  
Count forward beginning with a given number (0-75)  
Skip count by 5's to 100  
Solve addition/subtraction story problems 0-10 using manipulative  
Compose (construct) numbers 11-19 into tens and ones  
Decompose (separate) numbers 11-19 into tens and ones  
Identify dime and its value  
Describe and compare length and weight  
Identify story elements: character, setting  
Ask and answer questions about text  
Identify main topic and key details of informational text  
Read sight words  
Identify ending sound  
Identify letter sounds (uppercase and lowercase)  
Mm, Tt, Aa, Ss, Pp, Cc, Ii, Bb, Nn, Rr, Dd, Kk, Ff, Oo, Hh, Ll, Gg  
Write the letter for each sound (see above)  
Identify short and long vowel sounds  
Use letter-sound matches to decode VC & CVC words  
Add or substitute sounds to make new words  
Read emergent-reader texts with purpose & understanding  
Print upper- and lowercase letters:  
M, T, A, S, P, C, I, B, N, R, D, K, F, O, H, L, G  
Produce a complete sentence: create  
Draw/dictate/write to give information  
Write high frequency words  
Recognize and use sentence structure: capitalization, punctuation  
Use nouns and verbs  
Use prepositions when speaking or writing  
Identify multiple meanings for familiar words

Solve addition problems within 10  
Solve subtraction problems within 10  
Find the missing addend to make 10  
Fluently add and subtract within 10  
Identify quarter and its value  
Identify story elements: character, setting, plot  
Identify text features  
Read sight words  
Identify medial sound  
Identify letter sounds (uppercase and lowercase)  
Mm, Tt, Aa, Ss, Pp, Cc, Ii, Bb, Nn, Rr, Dd, Kk, Ff, Oo,  
Hh, Ll, Gg, Ee, Ww, Jj, Xx, Uu, Vv, Zz, Yy, Qq  
Write the letter for each sound (see above)  
Print upper- and lowercase letters  
M, T, A, S, P, C, I, B, N, R, D, K, F, O, H, L, G,  
E, W, J, X, U, V, Z, Y, Q  
Draw/dictate/write to tell a story  
Write high frequency words  
Write CVC words from dictation  
Recognize sentence structure: capitalization, punctuation, proper spacing  
Understand and use question words  
Uses inflections and affixes
